

FRUIT CITY Webinar

Preparations and content

Classes from the Nordic countries will gather online for a webinar, where you will be guided through the day by an expert team from Denmark. Prior to the webinar, you will receive a teacher's guide with specific tasks that you need to work on before and during the webinar. The creative idea is that all students should work with a certain fruit as inspiration for their sketches and prototypes. All the students products of the housing of the future will be part of a shared FRUIT CITY sustainable city presentation.





BEFORE the webinar

The students must work on two preparation tasks. You should expect approximately 2x45 minutes to be set aside for teaching activities before the webinar.

1 They need to create a mood board with target groups, materials and location for their home – then they are well prepared for the creative process!

2 They will collect materials for the creative prototyping process at the webinar. For example, paper, cardboard boxes, strings, plastic cans – you name it!

DURING the webinar

The webinar itself is held in English and changes between taking place online, where the hosts initiate assignments, and offline, where the class works independently with the tasks facilitated by you as a teacher. The classes work with this problem: *Based on sustainability principles, the class will come up with suggestions for the dream home of the future. They must gather knowledge before and during the webinar and use this in the preparation of a prototype of a home. The home will be part of the webinar's joint FRUIT CITY – a presentation of Nordic students' ideas for sustainable housing.*
